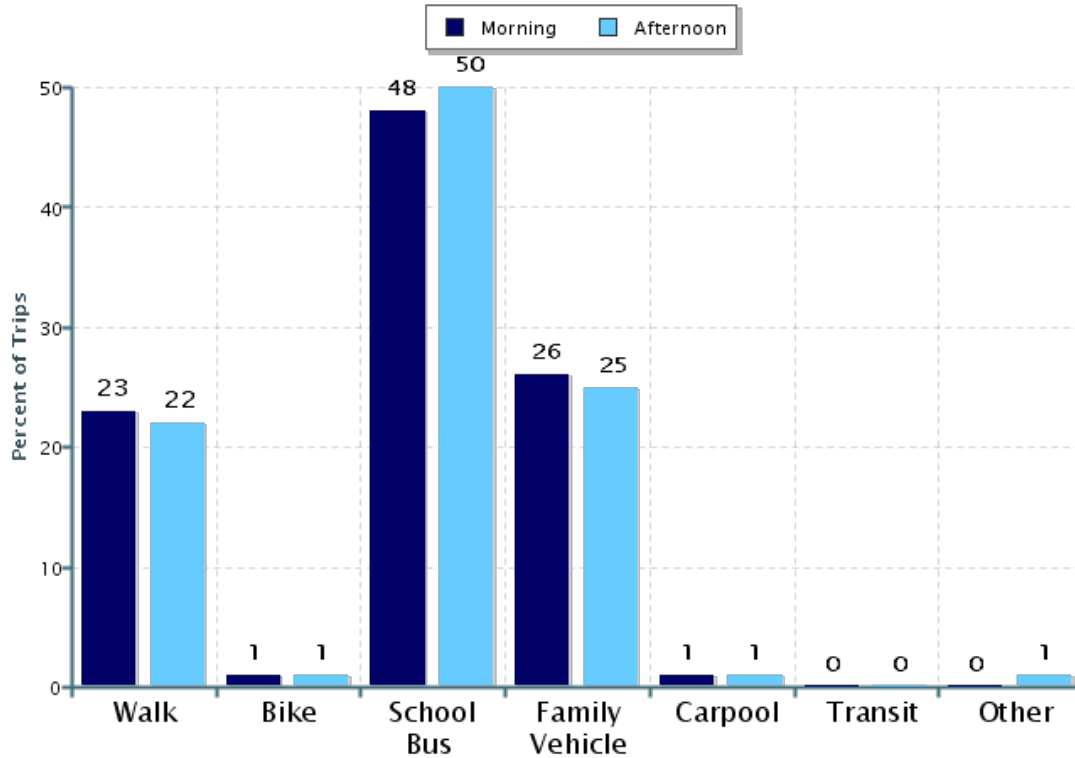

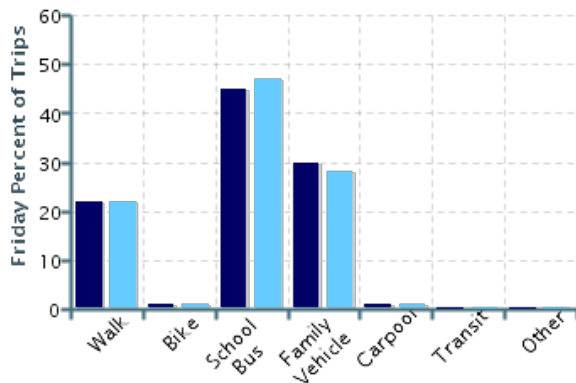

 ■ Afternoon

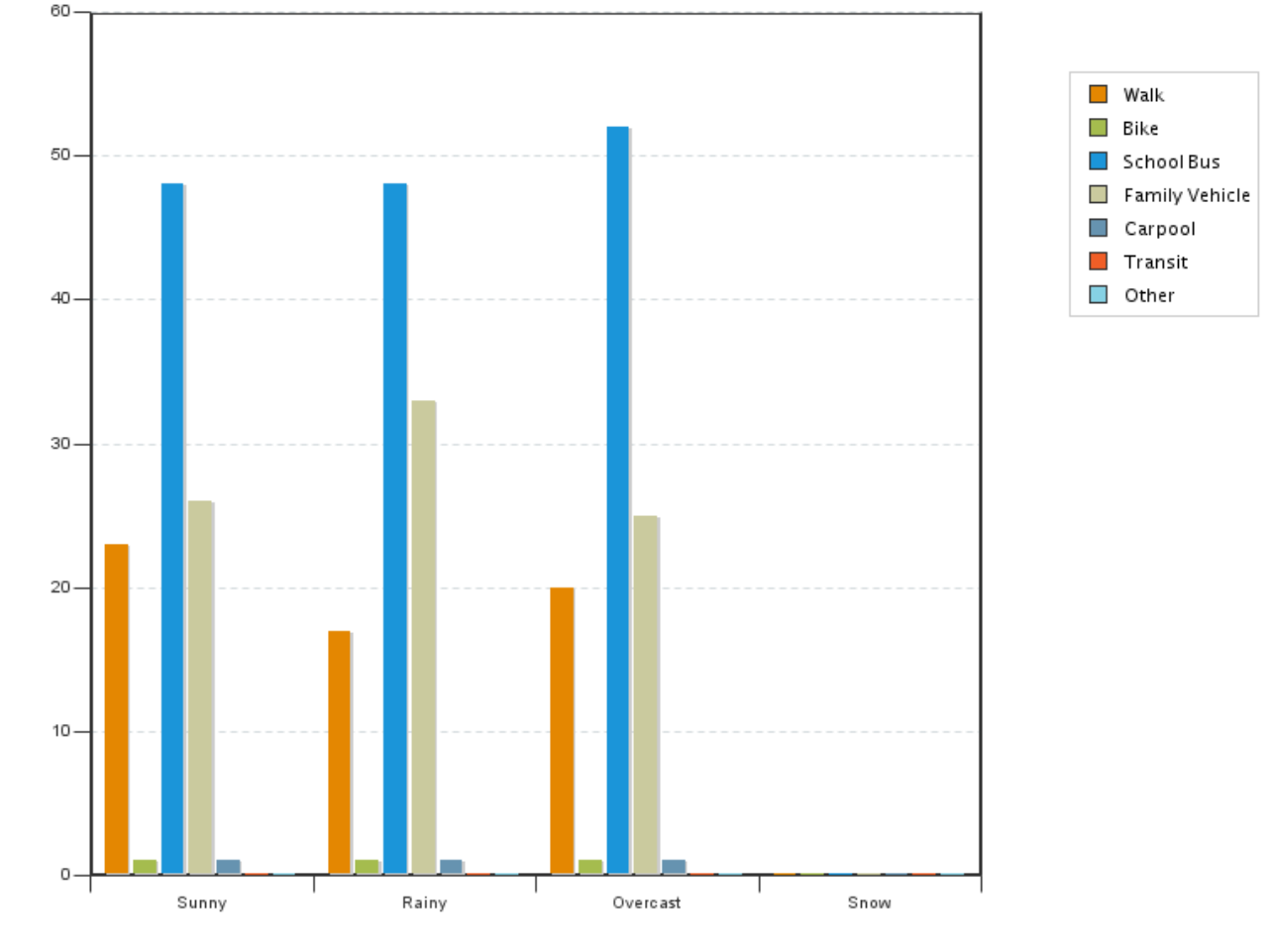
